Curriculum Vitae

Christina Deliyanni - Dimitrakou is a graduate of the Law School of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki. Following her postgraduate studies in International Private Law and International Social Law at the Faculty of Law of the University of Geneva (Switzerland), she obtained her PhD diploma from the same university. She is a Professor at the Law School of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, where she teaches Comparative Law and European Social Law at undergraduate and postgraduate levels as well as in the framework of the faculty's Erasmus Programme.

She has been a visiting professor at the Faculty of Law of the University of Dijon and Toulouse (France), while she is a member of the International Academy of Comparative Law, of the French Society of Comparative Legislation, the Greek Society of Labor Law and Social Security, the Thessaloniki Bar Association and of other scientific bodies. Additionally, in December 2013 she became a member of the Academic Network on the European Social Charter and Social Rights, managing the establishment and coordination of the Greek wing of the network. Since 2011 she is co-director of the Franco-Hellenic Master, which operates at the Law School of the University of Thessaloniki and Toulouse Capitol 1. In November 2016 she was appointed Secretary on the Centre of International and European Economic Law.

As a scientific co-coordinator and a member of various research groups, she has conducted several research programs funded by the European Union. Apart from Comparative Law and European Social Law, Prof. Christina Deliyanni - Dimitrakou has a wide range of interests including: Theory of Comparative Law, Major Legal Systems, Trust Law, European Tort Law, Comparative Non-Discrimination Law, Cultural and Social Rights.
